

ODEBOLT CITY - REGULAR MEETING

December 5, 2005 - CITY HALL, 7:30 P.M.

Present: Jim Scott, Butch Hemphill, Mary Jeanne Thompson, Mark Hansen, Todd Bengford, Mayor Ron Rex, Bill Tysor Police Chief Bruce Henderson, Attorney Joe Heidenreich, Keith Flink and Mike Hoefling.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Rex at 7:30 p.m. Roll call was answered by five councilmen. A motion was made by Hansen and seconded by Bengford to approve the agenda. A motion was made by Scott, seconded by Bengford to approve the minutes.

City Attorney Joe Heidenreich was present to answer questions on several items. No action will be taken until the January meeting.

Councilpersons elect, Keith Flink and Mike Hoefling were welcomed by the Mayor. Hemphill moved to approve the bills and Scott seconded the motion. A building permit for Shannon Railsback was approved by notion from Hansen and seconded by Bengford.

A resident has been cited in a nuisance complaint. Several downtown sidewalks are not being cleared of the snow. It was decided to have the city employees clean them. Bengford made a motion to approve the library report. Scott seconded the motion. The police report was discussed. One delinquent water bill needs to be paid.

The January Council Meeting will be on Tuesday, January 3.

Supervisor Tysor reported that something needs to be done on the garbage truck packer. It was decided to get bids for this. The sidewalk north of Dresselhuis and Heidenreich Law Firm will be replaced in the spring.

There is a problem with the aerators at the lagoon emitting too much nitrate. Tysor suggested we get prices on new aerators, as some are not lasting long enough.

Thompson and Hansen had no reports. Bengford had a complaint on Jake brakes used by truckers on the highway. A model ordinance on Jake brakes will come from another town with this ordinance.

Scott and Hemphill had no reports. A complaint on dog barking was read. The Mayor will confer with Police Chief Henderson.

The Sac County League will meet in Lake View on December 14. There has been no response from Brown on the building clearing grant.

A thank you for their years of service was given to Hansen and Thompson. Hansen moved to adjourn, seconded by Bengford. The meeting was adjourned.
