Moved by Flink and seconded by Hoefling to approve the Class C Liquor License and Outdoor Sales for Tiggers. Four ayes.

Moved by Flink and seconded by Bengford to approve the following permits as discussed: Steve Loger-chain link fence; Dick Bloyer-patio expansion; Bobbie & Everett Scott-underground utilities; OBC-trees (with stipulations); Virgene Friedrichsen-tiling; Mark Olson-deck & repair fence; Robert Harden tree. Four ayes.

Moved by Bengford and seconded by Scott to make a contribution to the Odebolt Development Corporation fundraiser for the repairs of the Café.

Moved by Flink and seconded by Hoefling to adopt Resolution #10.11-accepting the Street Finance Report. Four ayes.

Moved by Flink and seconded by Bengford to adopt Resolution #10.12-accepting the current Investment Policy with no changes. Four ayes.

Bengford reported that the park playground equipment is being installed and hopefully will be completed in three weeks.

Trick-or-Treat time is set for Sunday, October 31st from 5:00-7:00 p.m.

Several nuisances were discussed and four Notices to Abate will be sent.

Moved by Scott and seconded by Bengford to accept the Library report. Four ayes.

Moved by Scott and seconded by Flink to approve the Mayor's appointment of Kris Schroeder to the Library Board. Four ayes. (Pending approval by the County Board of Supervisors.)

The Law Enforcement Report was available for review. Barking dogs are a real problem in several neighborhoods.

Delinquent water bills that are not paid by Wednesday will be disconnected.

Supt. Tysor reported that Layne/Western will be in town tomorrow to test the wells. The sidewalk snow removal contract was approved at the same price as last year.

The financial report was available for review.

Bengford reviewed the end of the year report from CPO Stacy Pritchard and also the response to the pool inspection.

Scott reported that the street contractors had done a great job on the streets.

The M/M Ball Program greatly appreciates the contribution of \$1,500.00 from the City of Arthur.
