Ordinance 04.22

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF ODEBOLT, IOWA:

Title VI PHYSICAL ENVIRONMENT Chapter 8- Utilities-Billing Charges. 6-6-8 Water Rate and 6-6-10 Rate of Sewer Rent for All water will be changed to the following

Section 6-6-8 Chapter is hereby repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

WATER RATES. Water shall be furnished at the following monthly rates.

1. For property serviced within the City Limits:
(Code of IA, Se. 384.84(1))

The first 1,000 gallons will be assessed as part of the monthly minimum of \$20.60 from \$20.00

All Use over 1,000 gallons in a month will be charged at \$4.84 from \$4.70 per 1,000 gallons.

The minimum charge shall be \$20.60 per household or business building per billing month.

2. Properties serviced outside of the corporate limits of the city which the City has agreed to serve will be charged at 200% of the rates provided in 6-6-8 (1) of this chapter. No such customer will be served unless they have an agreement bound by the ordinances, rules and regulations applying to water service established by the City.

Section 6-6-10 Chapter is hereby repealed and the following adopted in lieu thereof:

RATE OF SEWER RENT AND MANNER OF PAYMENT.

The rate of sewer rent shall be based upon the net water bill for each premise. The rent shall be paid with the water bill at the same time as payment of the water bill is due and under the same condition as to penalty for late payment, at the office of the City Clerk, beginning with the next payment after enactment of this Ordinance, or, if connection has not been made, after the connection to the sewer system is made.

1. The sewer rent rate follows:

First 1,000 gallons of water used over the monthly billing period will be charged at \$17.00 from \$16.50. All use over 1,000 gallons shall be charged at \$4.84 from \$4.70 per 1,000 gallons (which will keep our compliance with SRF loans).


It was then moved by Council Member Peterson that said proposed ordinance be amended & adopted and published as by law required. Said motion was seconded by Council Member Carl Hemer.
